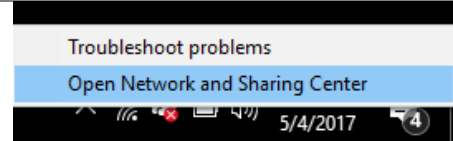




MCTC-WiFi Windows 10 Configuration

Right click the system tray Network icon in the lower right of your Windows 10 desktop near the clock and left click on “Open Network and Sharing Center.”

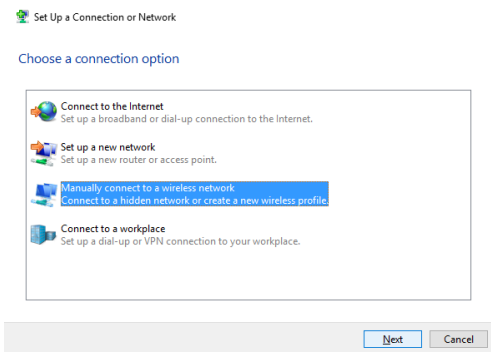

Under “Change your networking settings” click the **Set up a new connection or network** link.

When the Set Up a Connection or Network dialog box appears, choose Manually Connect to Wireless Network and then click Next.

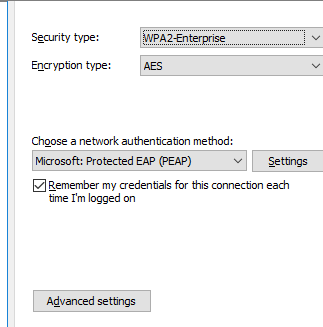

The Network properties dialog will open. Click the **security** tab.

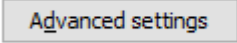
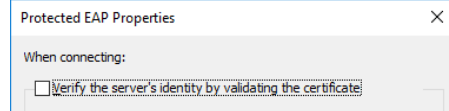

Under the EAP properties box uncheck the “Validate Server Certificate” check box.

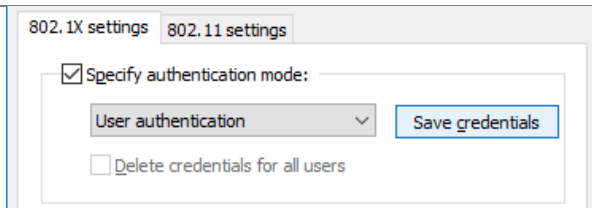
Click **OK**



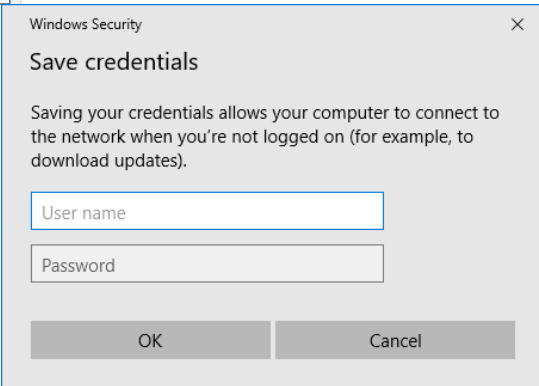
Click the **Advance Settings** button when the WiFi Network properties box.

Check the “**Specify authentication mode**” checkbox and choose “**User authentication**” and click the “**Save credentials**” button.



Type your MCTCNet user name (ex. smith1) and LOGIN password then click **OK**.

To complete the network setup, click **OK** on each dialog box.

Finally, click **CLOSE** on the connection settings dialog box.

You have completed the wireless configuration for **MCTC-WiFi**, you should now be able to connect.
