

## MCTC WorkKeys Testing

Assessment is the process of obtaining and judging evidence about the quality or amount of learning that has taken place. The purpose of gathering assessment data at MCTC is to monitor the quality of the academic programs and to improve the educational experience of students.

As a part of the requirements associated with your program major, you will be required to take the WorkKeys tests (Applied Mathematics, Locating Information, and Reading for Information,). These tests are given during the fall and spring semesters to students who will graduate in December and May and to all Health Information Technology, Medical Assistant, and Physical Therapist Assistant majors who will graduate in the summer. Each test takes 45 minutes or less. You will be given a testing schedule and information about WorkKeys during your capstone course and/or when you go to the MCTC Advising Center to register for graduation.

**You must have your Social Security number for the WorkKeys tests. You will also need your 901 number.**
