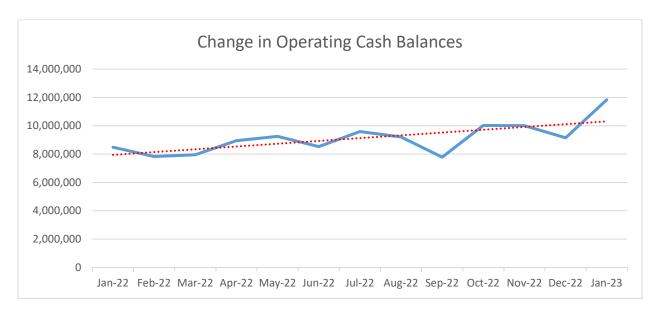

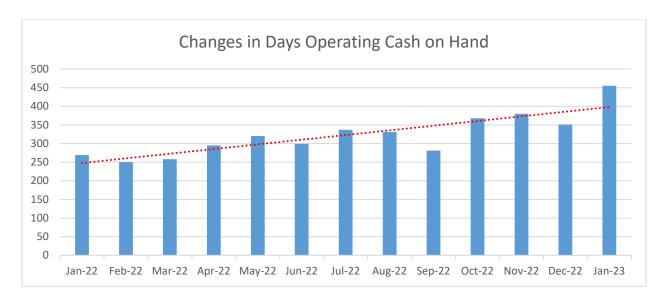
Cash Report:

The attached Cash Operating Budget Report is for January 2023 the 7th month of the 2023 Fiscal Year. The target for 7/12 of the year is 58% for revenue and expense if activity was spread equally over 12 months. Revenue is at 93% which is above target, and expenses are currently at 57%, which is slightly under the target.

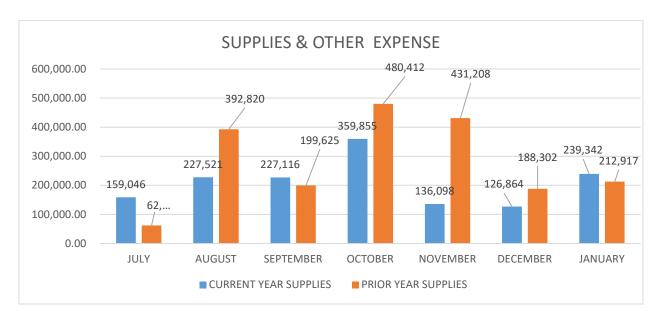


Cash at the end of January 2023 was approximately 40% higher than January 2022, for a \$3,353,889 difference. This large difference is primarily due to the timing of Spring 2023 influx of tuition in late January opposed to early February for Spring 2022. The number of days cash on hand remains strong at 455 days. Please note that in January 2022, the average monthly expenses were \$808,737 and the current average monthly expenses as of January 2023 are \$792,570, which is a decrease of approximately \$16,167 per month.

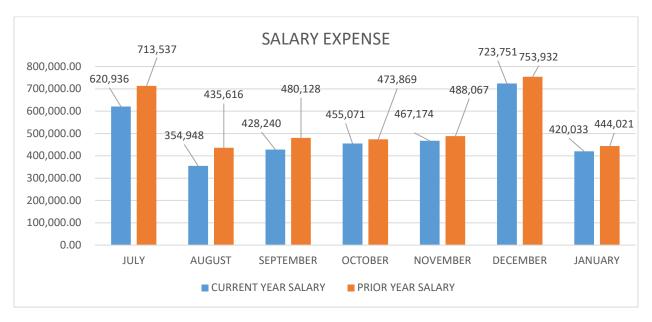
The number of days cash on hand in January 2023 is 455, and as of January 2022, it was 269 days, an increase of 186 days.

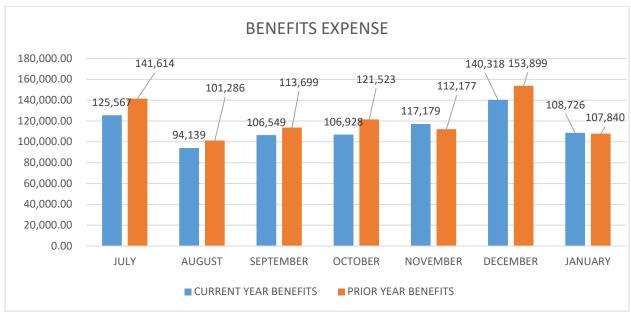


Supplies and Other expenses for January 2023 were \$239,342 which is slightly higher compared to \$212,917 in January 2022. The YTD Supplies and Other Expenses for FY23 are \$1,475,843 compared to \$1,967,565 for FY22, which is a decrease of \$491,722.



Salaries and Benefits for the month of January 2023 were \$420,033 and \$108,726 respectively, which is lower compared to \$444,021 and \$107,840 in January of last year. The YTD Salaries and Benefits for FY23 are \$3,470,154 and 799,405 compared to \$3,789,169 and \$852,037 for FY22, which is a decrease of \$319,015 and \$52,631 respectively.
