STATEMENT ON ACCREDITATION

The Physical Therapist Assistant Program at Mountwest Community & Technical College is accredited by the Commission on Accreditation in Physical Therapy Education (CAPTE), 3030 Potomac Avenue, Suite 100, Alexandria, Virginia 22305-3085; Telephone: 1-800-999-2792; email: accreditation@apta.org: website: www.capteonline.org. Graduation from an accredited program is required to be eligible for licensure.

STATEMENT ON PERFORMANCE EXPECTATIONS

Students should be aware that the academic performance expectations of this program are notably higher than what you may be accustomed to. This includes a 70% minimum performance requirement on each didactic measure (tests) as well as an 85% minimum performance requirement on each laboratory measure (practicals). Students who are unable to successfully demonstrate this minimum level of competency will not receive a passing grade and will be dismissed from the program. Applicants are encouraged to request a meeting with the program faculty as they complete their application if they have any questions regarding the programs academic policies.

STATEMENT ON BACKGROUND CHECK/DRUG SCREEN & LICENSING BOARD

Students with an arrest and/or criminal conviction may be unable to fulfill the clinical education requirements in order to graduate. Individuals with an arrest and/or criminal conviction are advised that the State Licensing Boards will consider their application for physical therapist assistant licensure on an individual basis. Upon graduation, you may be required to make a personal appearance before the board prior to be granted licensure. It is the prerogative of the licensing board to grant or deny the application for licensure.

Thank you for expressing interest in the Physical Therapist Assistant (PTA) Program at MCTC. Enclosed are the forms and instructions necessary to initiate the process for consideration of admission into the Class of 2026. Please review the entire packet and read the instructions carefully before completing the forms.

The PTA Program is an accredited 14-month (upon admission) Associate in Applied Science Degree program designed to prepare a general Physical Therapist Assistant practitioner who will engage in lifelong professional development. The program includes classroom, laboratory and clinical learning experiences. Students participate in 18 weeks of full-time clinical affiliations throughout the program. As a member of the MCTC Career & Technical Division, there is ample opportunity for PTA students to interact with students in a number of health care disciplines.

Admission to the PTA program at MCTC is a competitive process. The program faculty values a well-rounded applicant, one who has demonstrated his/her academic and cognitive abilities as well as his/her personal and professional potential. The PTA Admissions Committee will evaluate candidates on the basis of their academic aptitude and demonstrated achievement, personal recommendations and interview presentation. The program anticipates admission of 18 students per year.

Application Deadline:

All application materials must be received on or before <u>March 15, 2026</u>. If any of your application materials are received after the stated deadline, your application will be incomplete and you will not be considered for admission.

Since the number of seats available for students in the physical therapist assistant program are limited, deadlines must be met in order to allow the program to determine the applicant's eligibility for admission in a timely manner. Aptitude Exam and interviews are not automatically awarded to all applicants.

Non-Discrimination Statement:

The PTA Program prohibits preferential or adverse discrimination on the basis of race, age, color, religion, marital status, national or ethnic origin, citizenship status, sex, sexual orientation, veteran status or the presence of a medical condition or disability status in all areas including but not limited to its qualifications for program admission, activities and policies. The program is committed to promoting cultural diversity throughout the profession.

- Recent revision to the admission criteria includes an increase in the minimum cumulative GPA
 requirement from 2.0 to 2.50. This number reflects <u>all</u> college level academic work that you
 have completed up to the time you are applying to the program.
- All applicants advancing beyond the initial screening will be <u>conditionally</u> enrolled in the PTA 100 Introduction to PT and PTA 160- Neuroanatomy and Physiology courses scheduled during the summer semester. The PTA 100 course is also being offered as an open enrollment course during the Spring 2026 semester so if a student is in the process of completion of the course, they will not be conditionally enrolled. Maintaining this enrollment is <u>contingent</u> upon your eventual full admission to the program. This preliminary enrollment in the PTA 100 and 160 courses <u>does not guarantee</u> your full admission to the program.

If you are not fully admitted at the conclusion of the application cycle, you will be administratively withdrawn from these courses at that time. If you have additional questions contact the program offices for more information.

- The full (final) admission decisions will go out via email in mid-May following receipt and review of spring grades from the registrar's office.
- The PTA 100 course is tentatively scheduled in the summer to run during session B (May 11th thru June 11th) and the PTA 160 course is tentatively scheduled in the summer to run during session A (May 11th thru July 16th).
