Mountwest's JumpStart program offers dual credit college courses for eligible high school juniors and seniors enrolled in public, private, or homeschool programs in West Virginia. Students select a pathway where courses count toward both high school graduation and college requirements, helping them move forward without adding extra years—or extra debt.
