Program Description:

The STAND program recognizes registered apprenticeship training as college credit toward an Associate of Applied Science in Skilled Trades. This degree option is only available to individuals who are currently enrolled in or have successfully completed a registered apprenticeship program recognized by the U.S. Department of Labor, are a U.S. citizen or legal resident who meets federal student aid residency requirements, and have maintained West Virginia residency for at least one year prior to application.

Program Outcomes:

- The student will compose coherent, unified written documents that demonstrate correct mechanics and style, as well as appropriate documentation of sources.
- The student will communicate verbal and nonverbal messages appropriate to the audience and situation.
- The Student will use appropriate evidence and sound reasoning to make a judgement
- The student will demonstrate an understanding of the complexity of elements important to members of another culture in relation to history, values, politics, communication styles, economy, or beliefs and practices.
- The student will apply mathematical reasoning to solve quantitative problems
