

Spring 2027 Sponsored Scholarships

Mountwest Community & Technical College offers a variety of sponsored scholarship based on academic achievement, leadership, community involvement, area of study and financial need.

Amount of Scholarships

Sponsored scholarships vary per semester, with most averaging \$500. In most cases, sponsored scholarships are a one-time award.

Scholarships for New Mountwest Students

Incoming Mountwest students may be eligible for a number of sponsored scholarships. In addition to the requirements outlined in this guide, all new students applying for scholarships must have submitted their completed application for admission to the college. Students with Financial Need

Some scholarships are designated specifically for students demonstrating financial need. File the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) prior to the deadline to be considered for all scholarships and need-based financial assistance.

Unless otherwise specified, your application will include an essay answer {300-500 words) to the question. *“How will this scholarship impact my life and help me achieve my educational/career goals?”*

- Be a student who is a cancer survivor or currently undergoing treatment, with breast cancer patients having priority. Students with chronic or debilitating condition(s) can be considered as well. Medical documentation of condition must be provided from all applicants.
- Be a dependent 26 years old or younger of a parent or guardian with cancer; or a survivor.
- Be a student of Mountwest Community & Technical College, with at least one semester completed at time of award.
- Be in good academic standing with a 2.5 cumulative grade point average or higher.
- Show a demonstrated financial need, as determined by the Office of Financial Aid. Additional Information. The award shall be renewable up to three semesters, if enrollment requirement and a minimum 2.5 grade point average are maintained.

Recipients must:

- a. be an undergraduate full- or part-time student seeking a Vet Tech certificate or associate's degree at Mountwest Community & Technical College.
- b. Must be enrolled at Mountwest to receive the scholarship.
- c. Spend 20 hours per semester doing community service at the Cook School building/ Animal Shelter during the semester in which the scholarship is awarded.
- d. The expectation is the scholarship would not fund 100% of the tuition, books and fees of the program so the student would have some "skin in the game". But the hope is that it would be a significant portion of the annual costs to allow more students in the program.
- e. The scholarship would be able to continue for that student's entire program as long as they maintain a 2.5 grade point average and stay in the Vet Tech program.
